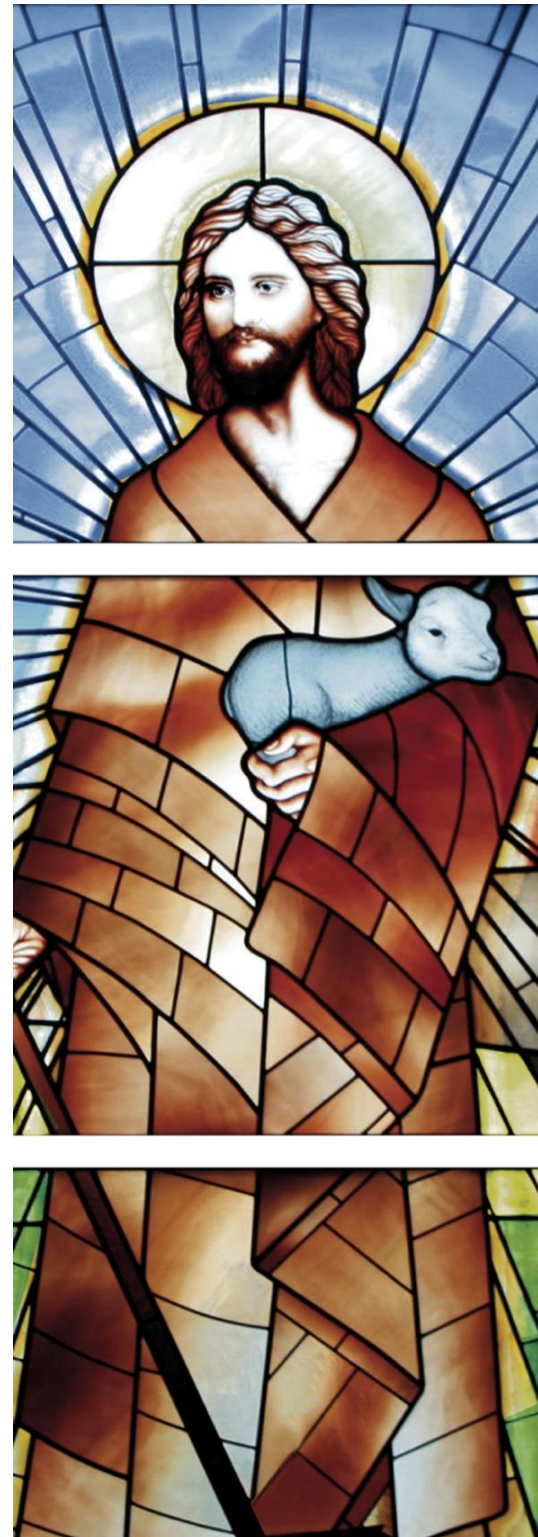
The SVLC Langley Housing Society's Annual General Meeting will be postponed until Wednesday, May 15th at 6:00 pm. The meeting will be held in the hall.
